Supported Living

Enham's Supported Living teams support service users to live in their own homes and in the community by helping with everyday activities such as shopping, meal planning and preparation, travel, managing finances, learning, employment, social relationships and leisure.

-  Enham can offer a choice of Supported Living Services for people with learning, physical and mental health disabilities.
-  Our Supported Living Services are regularly monitored and reviewed by Hampshire County Council's Supporting People team.
-  Support is available from one hour per week to a maximum of 17.5 hours. Each service user will have his or her needs individually assessed and a Support Plan agreed with them.
-  Our skilled staff are on hand to assist service users with housing-related issues.
-  All staff have an enhanced Criminal Record Bureau check and have undergone comprehensive induction and training programmes.
-  Enham is a Registered Social Landlord, monitored by the Housing Corporation.

Winchester and Test Valley

This is a floating support service available for people with learning disabilities aged from 16 years. Service users will live in the Test Valley or Winchester areas.

Enham Alamein

Alexandra House

Alexandra House, which can accommodate 34 people, is a complex comprising of bungalows, flats and bed-sit accommodation.

Enham Alamein village

Housing-related support is available to service users living in all parts of the village.

Service users in Winchester, Test Valley, Alexandra House and the village of Enham Alamein receive Supported Living Services funded by Hampshire County Council's Supporting People team.

Weston Court

Weston Court is a pleasant complex, comprising 15 bungalows with 2 bedrooms, for shared occupancy by careful selection. Service users are funded either privately or by their local authority. The funding provided is used to meet their housing-related support needs, or home care for their personal care needs.

Weston Court provides an ideal environment where service users are supported to gain further skills and experience before progressing to longer term accommodation – offering a stepping stone to independence.

Emergency support

All service users receiving Supported Living Services in Enham Alamein are provided with Life Line Alarms, to give 24 hours a day/seven days a week support in the case of emergencies.



Open Days

We have monthly Open Days for the Supported Living, Residential Care and Development Programme services.
