Enham's Journey to Work programme supports young people with barriers or health issues, into work. We can help you into learning, training, work placements or paid employment through a dedicated programme solely for your age group.

## Who is eligible?

- ▶ Those aged 16 to 25 years of age
- ▶ Those living in Dorset or Somerset
- ▶ Those unemployed and facing barriers getting into employment

## How we can help

We can provide you with individual support, information, advice and guidance to access:

- ▶ Training or Learning
- ▶ Work Placements
- ▶ Voluntary work
- ▶ Full-time or part-time paid work

We can help as long as you have officially left education and have barriers that have prevented you taking up any of the above.

Our service is free; all you have to do is spend some time choosing the options that best suits your needs and then make a commitment to achieving them.



### These include:

- ▶ Access to one to one support with an employment adviser in your local area
- ▶ Access to training or learning opportunities in your local area
- ▶ Help in finding work placements with an employer of your choice
- ▶ Assistance with C.V. writing, job applications, and interview skills and time management
- ▶ Support in finding voluntary work
- ▶ Support to secure full-time or part-time work



Once you begin full time or part time paid employment we will support you for a further 13 weeks. During that time we will set up a mentor to ensure that our support continues even when you have left the programme.
