Transitional Supported Living Service

Enham's transitional supported living service offers assistance to adults (aged 18+) with physical, learning or mental health disabilities. You may have moved out of home or finished college and are keen to be independent. We offer a stepping-stone approach to moving on to independent living.

Our service is designed for a duration of up to two years per individual, before progressing on to a more permanent type of accommodation.

Where is Enham's Transitional Supported Living located?

It is based at Weston Court, Enham Alamein near Andover in Hampshire. Weston Court is an idyllic complex of 15 bungalows, each with 2 bedrooms for shared occupancy, with a careful selection process.

Enham village has a shop/post office, café, community hall, garage and a church. There is a public bus service and Enham also operates a transport service. There is also a main line train station at nearby Andover.

We can provide:

- ▶ An **Assessment** of the support and care you need.
- ▶ **Life planning**, which is agreed with you to help you build up your confidence and learn the skills you need to live independently, such as:
 - Shopping
 - Meal planning & preparation
 - Travel
 - Managing finances
 - Learning
 - Employment
 - Social Relationships
 - Leisure
- ▶ **Training** modules to gain specific experience, knowledge and skills: Available through our Development Programme.
- ▶ **Support:** Delivered by a team of carefully selected, trained and dedicated staff.
- ▶ **Reassurance:** All our bungalows are fitted with lifeline alarm systems should an emergency arise.
- ▶ An **Out of Hours Service** 24 hours a day 7 days a week – calls are received by our highly trained call centre staff, they will assist by either calling the emergency services, talking through any concerns OR by contacting our on-call staff to visit or telephone you.

How is it funded?

This service is funded by the relevant local authority, or privately purchased.

Enham is a charity dedicated to service provision for disabled and disadvantaged people. Established in 1919, we work to empower disabled and disadvantaged people to reach their potential, providing an innovative and personalised range of learning programmes, employment opportunities, housing and care options.
